Kyle William Douglas, 16, of Beloit, WI, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, March 8, 2021 in his home.

He was born on September 9, 2004. The son of Richard and Suanna (Summers) Douglas.

Kyle graduated from Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic School. He was currently a Sophomore at Boylan Catholic High School where he was part of the swim team.

Kyle was a member of the Boy Scout Troop #608 and volunteered doing community service work. He enjoyed boating, camping, the outdoors, watching cheesy disaster movies, and online gaming. Kyle was also a reader and liked the "Wings of Fire" book series. He was always the first person to lend a hand. Kyle was the "little monkey" of the family.

Survivors include his parents, Richard and Suanna Douglas; brother, James and sister, Katrina.
